Periodontics Residency Training Program at King Abdulaziz Medical City – Ministry of National Guard Health Affairs, Riyadh is one of the leading and largest programs in periodontics in Saudi Arabia with the mission to train and produce experts in advanced periodontics and implant dental surgery. The program provides residents with the highest level of evidence based scientific knowledge, expertise, and clinical skills. The program focuses on educating and training residents to achieve the highest competency in prevention, diagnosis, treatment planning, and treatment of periodontal disease and dental implant therapy.

Acceptance to the program is in accordance with the SCFHS training rules and regulations. Accepted resident are expected to abide by training regulations established by the SCFHS and those of the training center:

The program accepts 2 residents each year. Candidates nominated for interviews are assessed on their attitude, communication skills, goals, and professionalism. Additionally, the following factors are taken into consideration for acceptance: academic records, achievements, research activity, references, dental and nondental experiences, volunteer work, and community work.

This is a 4-year full-time residency program at King Abdul-Aziz Medical City that complies with the SCFHS approved Periodontics curriculum. Training includes didactics covering classic and current scientific evidence. Additionally, clinical training sessions comprehensively cover all aspects of nonsurgical and surgical treatment modalities. Under the supervision and guidance of highly qualified academic and clinical faculty members, residents can achieve the required level of competency needed for success as periodontal and dental implant experts.

Resident evaluations are based on SCFHS approved assessment tools. Residents are expected to complete and document a set number of surgical cases. After successful completion of the program residents will be eligible for the Saudi Board for Periodontics Examination.
